

TMRA Camping Rules

Camping on the TMRA grounds is dry camping only. There are no utilities (water, electrical, sewer and/or etc.), for your use. You are not allowed to hook up to any of existing electrical outlets or water spigots. The only restrooms available on-site are the porta potty type. We have no facilities for you to dump RV (black & gray water) holding tanks. No dumping of these types of fluids onto the ground is allowed.

Horses

TMRA may have pens available to rent, if so it will be posted separately. You are welcome to utilize your own portable pens or tie to your trailers. If you do so, you are required to clean-up all waste from your horse(s) and take it with you or dispose of it in one of the on-site dumpsters.

Noise

Quiet hours are from 11 pm to 7am

Dogs

Polite pets are welcome but they must be kept on a leash at all times. You are also required to pick up after your dog.

Fires

No campfires are allowed on TMRA grounds.

Garbage

All garbage is required to be removed from your campsite and taken with you or properly disposed of in the on-site dumpster

Liability/Leave No Trace

If you choose to camp @ the Rodeo Grounds it is @ your own risk, TMRA is not responsible in any fashion for the safety or well-being of you, your animals, or any of your equipment. We hope you enjoy camping @ our facility. However, it is expected that when you pack-up and go home, you leave no trace and we are not responsible to clean-up after you. If this becomes an issue, camping will no longer be allowed.
