

Howdy Vendors,

Thank you again for vending at this year's Benz Bad Bulls and/or Mountain Fest PRCA Rodeo. We know the crowd will appreciate all of your hard work. We do too! Below is information that will help you have a successful event with us.

Vendors

\$75 per day non-food Vendors

\$250 total for all 4 events non-food Vendors

Food Vendors

\$125 per day Food Vendors

\$100 per day Food Vendors if attending all 4 events

\$20 flat fee to connect to our Starlink WIFI

You are responsible for all seller permits and health permits, the health department will be there.

Each Booth is 10x10, unless you have purchased more space. Upon request of the fans, we have moved the layout of vendors around a bit so you may not be in the same spot as times before. We will have someone there at check-in to show you to your spot. Spots are assigned and your name will be at your location. Please be respectful of others getting unloaded and move your vehicle as soon as unloaded.

YOU MAY LEAVE YOUR BOOTH SET UP OVERNIGHT IF YOU WISH - AT YOUR OWN RISK. TMRA is not responsible for lost or stolen merchandise.

SET UP: Use gate at the North end of the facility next to the large white roll off dumpster for entry.

\*You do not need to check in again if your booth is already set up from the previous day.

FRIDAY 4th of July: Check-In/Set-Up 8am-1pm. Gates open at 4pm.

FRIDAY 8/15: Check-In/ Set-Up 8am-1pm. Gates open at 5pm.

SATURDAY 8/16: Check-In/Set-Up 8am-1pm. Gates open at 4pm.

SUNDAY 8/17: Check-In/Set-Up 8am-10am. Gates open at 12pm.

If you plan to leave after setup and arrive before gates open, leave PLENTY of time to arrive early as lines to get in get very long around the time gates open.

PLEASE PRINT and have your vendor parking pass in the car or you will be charged for parking (it will be emailed to you). We will have a designated vendor parking area in the south-west corner of the fairgrounds and it will be labeled for you.

At check in, each non-food booth will get 2 helper wristbands. Each food booth will get 6. If you need more please contact this email ahead of time. At the 4th of July event, we had issues with vendor wristband holders trying to access the VIP area and arguing with volunteers when they were not allowed access (yes, seriously!) A wristband only grants access to general seating/vendor areas. If this happens again, the vendors responsible will not be invited back.

There is only minimum power, 1 cord to each booth, enough to run lights, if you need more, you will need to bring a generator.

Everyone was awesome at last years' events but it must be said: We are all freakin' volunteers! We will do our best to accommodate you and make everyone happy, but we don't get paid enough to deal with grouchy Karens (considering we don't get paid at all).
